



The incel worldview


- women are responsible for incels' lack of sexual or romantic success
- establishing romantic relationships is determined by appearance/genetics
- incels are victims of both women and genetics
- women's freedom to choose their sexual partners should be taken away
- some believe that sexual violence, slavery and rape are justified
- some encourage extreme behaviour and violence against women and wider society
- social media posts often revere self-proclaimed incel mass murderers Elliot Rodgers and Alek Minassian



Misogyny and extremist ideology

- patriarchal systems in extremist ideologies and extremist groups are prevalent
- belief in the patriarchal system can lead to gender-based discrimination and violence
- misogynist perspectives can overlap with extremist ideologies that encourage and/or support extremism and violence

- attacks are often aimed at the school the individual attended



Identifying if it's a Prevent concern

Listen and make notes

What has the individual said or done that suggests extreme ideology?

Are there any indicators of radicalisation?

Did they check with the right people?

Do you need more information to make a decision?

Are there any additional indicators of a Prevent concern?

Are there any susceptibilities or complex needs?

Do you think the individual should be referred to Prevent?

Recap

- Emerging and other ideologies are currently a low terrorist risk
- Incel worldview is founded on the hatred of women and a belief that incels are being sexually oppressed by both women and society
- Massacre is a fascination with extreme violence or mass casualty attacks, which may crossover with incel or extreme right-wing ideologies
- Extreme left-wing and anarchist ideologies believe in the destruction of institutions/establishments that are perceived to be hierarchical, corrupt, or harmful
- Single-issue causes, such as climate change, the environment, or animal rights become extreme when criminal or violent actions are used to achieve goals



Ask yourself

What is the risk of the person becoming involved in or supporting terrorism?



National Prevent referral form



 you should use the national referral form to help to explain your concern to a Designated Safeguarding Lead (DSL) or an equivalent

- all Prevent referrals must be sent to the police for assessment
- your local authority or police can give details of where to send completed forms
- contact your local authority or police Scotland / Wales for an editable version

OFFICIAL SENSITIVE when complete

National Prevent referral form

This form is designed to help articulate a concern under Prevent – where you are worried a person is susceptible to radicalisation. Complete as much of the form as you are able; doing so will ensure that the person gets the help they need to keep them and others safe.

If you are a member of public sector staff, and would like to check your concern, you should contact your organisation's Designated Safeguarding Lead (DSL) or equivalent. If you are a member of the public and are concerned about someone, you should call the Act_Early_Support_Line on 0800 011 3764, in confidence to share your concerns with a specially trained officer or you can call the Anti-Terrorism Hotline on 0800 789 321. More information on what to do if you have a concern is available under "Get help for radicalisation concerns" on GOV.UK.

If you are deaf, hard of hearing or have a speech impairment, a police non-emergency number is available as a text phone service on 18001 101. Remember, in an emergency dial 999.

Once you have completed this form it is essential that you submit it to the police directly, or your DSL or equivalent will do this on your behalf. Where possible you will receive a response on your referral, but this is not always possible due to data-protection considerations and other sensitivities.

Where possible, do not leave any gaps, as the police may have to contact you to gather more information which will delay the process. If you cannot answer a question, explain why in the text box provided.
