<b>MARAC</b>	Multi-Agency Risk Assessment Conference	<i>Local agencies meet to discuss the highest risk victims of domestic abuse in their area in order to reduce the risk of serious harm or homicide for a victim and to increase safety, health and wellbeing of victims, both adults and any children.</i>
